#### Article 1 ENGINEER - DUTIES

##### **473.1.1 Application - approval - supervision**

In any case after an application has been received, the Brant County District Health Unit shall recommend that sanitary conveniences should be installed in any building within the limits of the City of Brantford and private drain connections constructed therefor, and such Board is of opinion that if the owner of the premises is unable to pay the expense of the same at once, suitable sanitary conveniences may be installed and private drain connections required to connect the same with the common sewers of the municipality constructed, upon the approval being obtained in each instance of the Committee of Finance; and it shall be the duty of the Engineer to cause such installation and construction to be made and done and to superintend the same through his/her department.

**473.1.2 Report - cost - to Clerk**

The Engineer shall upon the completion of such work in each instance report the cost of the same to the Clerk of the municipality.

**Article 2****CLERK - DUTIES****473.2.1 Cost - added - to Collector's Roll - interest - payment**

It shall be the duty of the Clerk of the municipality to add to the Collector's Roll in respect of the premises in which such sanitary conveniences are installed and to which such private drain connections are constructed during each year for a period of five years an equal proportionate part of the cost of such installation and construction including interest thereon at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum on such deferred payments, and such instalments and interest shall be collected in like manner as municipal taxes.
